Move Ups

Prior to the trial, move ups must be received in writing (email accepted) no later than Monday, September 14, 2020 at 6:00 pm. Additionally, move ups will be allowed for Saturday and Sunday during the trial as a result of receiving a title.

Eligible Dogs

This trial is open to **Beagles**, fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Exceptions are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Jump Height Card Process

There is a new section in the middle of the entry form to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Entry Fees

Fee for Saturday and Sunday trials: First class entry per day: \$22 per run. Fee for additional classes per day: \$18 per run/per dog. **Entry fee for Monday \$22 per run/trial** Checks should be made out to **NBC**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Please note, express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Confirmations

For those who provide an e-mail address entry received confirmations will be sent as entries are received. Entry accepted confirmations will be sent after the draw. Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent via e-mail. Confirmation via the postal service will only occur if you enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard with your entry. Judging schedule, worker schedule and exhibitor information will also be available on the trial secretary website, www.loulees-shelties.com after closing.

Refunds

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason if the request is received prior to closing by the Trial Secretary in writing or e-mail. After closing and prior to the trial starting, entry fees (less \$6/per run. for AKC and administrative fees) will be refunded for injured dogs, injured handlers, COVID- 19 ill until trial and bitches in season. The Trial Committee may require a doctor/vet's letter for injuries. Refund requests received after the start of the Trial will not be given for any reason.

- **Policy for Refunds if the Show is Cancelled AFTER Closing**
- If there are expenses associated with the show that cannot be ameliorated, those expenses will be paid. After covering any 2020 expenses, any remaining financial donations will be transferred to the 2021 National Beagle Club of America National Specialty. We are being very careful not to commit funds until we are sure, but there are items that must be pre-planned and paid for. We will make every effort to be sure we can have the show prior to closing. 100% of Entry Fees will be refunded.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made. Minor children must be supervised at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. This includes bark collars.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated agility warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean future use. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show grounds
- **AVMA Statement:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases.
 - **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS**
- As it pertains to the current COVID-19 pandemic, the following additional rules/laws/regulations shall apply to all exhibitors entering these shows. Exhibitors agree to hold the show giving club, the National Beagle Club of America, and the American Kennel Club harmless in respect to these rules. Exhibitors entering these shows do so at their own risk understanding that the club will abide by all rules and laws of the city, county, state and local municipalities. These rules may change between the release of this premium list, the closing time for entries and up to the starting time of the event. Every effort will be made to keep all exhibitors apprised of such changes. Any changes to said rules/laws/regulations will be sent out with the exhibitor acknowledgements and the show giving club will post any changes to said rules/laws/regulations at the event site 30 minutes prior to the time of judging.
- No one may attend these events if they (or any family member) have active COVID-19 or have tested positive for COVID-19 or are otherwise not in good health. (If any exhibitor has previously tested positive, they must be able to provide proof of antibodies).
- All Federal, State and Local guidelines MUST be followed, without exception, i.e., the use of gloves, masks, social distancing, etc. apply to all participants. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes will be supplied by the NBC.
- All Suggested Best Practices as provided by the AKC will be followed by the NBC and attendees.

- A minimum of 6 feet between exhibitor set-ups will be maintained. There will be no sharing of equipment, including chairs.
- Judges will use hand sanitizer after examining each dog and will instruct the handler to show teeth and bites.
- Handlers WILL NOT bring client dogs to the show site if the client or anyone in the client's family had, were symptomatic for or tested positive for COVID-19.
- Any individual violating these rules will be asked to leave.
- An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

Awards

- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st thru 4th place. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

- Special rosettes will be awarded for dogs completing the: PAX, MX, MXJ, MXP, and M XJP titles. New title and QQ ribbons will be awarded. All prizes will be claimed the day of the trial. None will be mailed.
- Saturday and Sunday, we are offering High in Trial Regular and High in Trial Preferred (all entered dogs are eligible).
- SIGN UP SHEETS WILL BE POSTED each day for the Following HIT Awards: HIT Champion dogs must have earned a CH or GCH by trial date), HIT Veteran and HIT Veteran Preferred (dogs must be 9 years or older by trial date), HIT Junior (handler must be 18 years or younger).
- Saturday HIT awards will be beagle agility motif ring bags. Sunday HIT awards will be Hand Painted Wall Plaque. Rosettes will also be awarded for these HIT awards.
- HIT awards will be calculated on a weighted basis using yards per second and a weight factor from the qualifying runs in Standard & JWW classes Saturday and Sunday.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
