CUT-OFF DATE FOR RESERVATIONS

Reservations must be received no later than August 27, 2020. The Hotel will continue to accept reservations after the cut-off date on a space and rate available basis only.
Contracted room rate is \$128.00 plus taxes.

SITE RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES FOR EXHIBITORS

All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.

THE National Beagle Club of America, Inc. will require all attendees to place hotel provided sheets of plastic to place under the crates. Up to five dogs will be permitted per room.

Housekeepers will not service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rule violation to hotel management. A pet deposit of \$10.00 per day, per room will be charged for each room in which a dog is housed. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction.

Dogs will be bathed in designated areas for dog washing. There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for this purpose.

THERE IS NO OVERNIGHT CRATING OF DOGS ALLOWED IN THE ROBERTS CENTRE UNTIL SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20. NO SETUP FOR GROOMING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE ROBERTS CENTRE WILL BE ALLOWED UNTIL AFTER 2:00 pm, ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20.

Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas, including the swimming pools and any other areas to be stipulated as "non-dog" locations.

Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, with the exception of those assisting the disabled.

THE National Beagle Club of America, Inc. will work with hotel management to establish a sufficient number of dog walking/exercising areas for all. The National Beagle Club of America, Inc. and management will create a site map with the designated areas clearly marked. These areas will also be staked and marked with colored tape so it is evident where they are located.

No exercise pens allowed around the front of Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field and Hotel. Exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged.

All dogs are required to be on-leash at Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field and Hotel at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged).

Pick up and removal of waste will be the responsibility of each dog owner/handler.

THERE WILL BE NO BLOW DRYERS ALLOWED INDOORS OF THE ROBERTS CENTRE. NBC COMMITTEE IS WORKING WITH THE ROBERTS CENTRE TO FIND AN APPROPRIATE AREA OUTDOORS, BUT IT MAY NOT BE POSSIBLE.

No Soft Sided Crates in Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Convention Centre doors must be closed during event hours for safety of the dogs. Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field /Roberts Centre/Holiday Inn will take no responsibility to ensure doors remain closed.

Your dogs may be left & crated in Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field overnight. Security will be provided from 10:30 pm to 6:00 am. Regular building hours are from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm unless otherwise noted

NBC EXHIBITORS AND VISITORS WILL COMPLY WITH ANY AND ALL COVID-19 MANDATES SET FORTH BY THE GOVERNOR OF OHIO AT THE TIME OF THE NATIONAL, INCLUDING THE DAY BEFORE AND THE DAY AFTER.

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult, when on the grounds.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

As it pertains to the current COVID-19 pandemic, the following additional rules/laws/regulations shall apply to all exhibitors entering these shows. Exhibitors agree to hold the show giving club, the National Beagle Club of America, and the American Kennel Club harmless in respect to these rules. Exhibitors entering these shows do so at their own risk understanding that the club will abide by all rules and laws of the city, county, state and local municipalities. These rules may change between the release of this premium list, the closing time for entries and up to the starting time of the event. Every effort will be made to keep all exhibitors apprised of such changes. Any changes to said rules/laws/regulations will be sent out with the exhibitor acknowledgements and the show giving club will post any changes to said rules/laws/regulations at the event site 30 minutes prior to the time of judging.

No one may attend these events if they (or any family member) have active COVID-19 or have tested positive for COVID-19, or are otherwise not in good health. (If any exhibitor has previously tested positive they must be able to provide proof of antibodies).

All Federal, State and Local guidelines MUST be followed, without exception, i.e., the use of gloves, masks, social distancing, etc. apply to all participants. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes will be supplied by the NBC.

All Suggested Best Practices as provided by the AKC will be followed by the NBC and attendees.

A minimum of 6 feet between exhibitor set-ups will be maintained. There will be no sharing of equipment, including chairs.

Judges will use hand sanitizer after examining each dog and will instruct the handler to show teeth and bites.

Handlers WILL NOT bring client dogs to the show site if the client or anyone in the client's family had, were symptomatic for or tested positive for COVID-19.

Any individual violating these rules will be asked to leave.

Policy for Refunds if the Show is Cancelled AFTER Closing

If there are expenses associated with the show that cannot be ameliorated, those expenses will be paid. After covering any 2020 expenses, any remaining financial donations will be transferred to the 2021 National Beagle Club of America National Specialty. We are being very careful not to commit funds until we are sure, but there are items that must be pre-planned and paid for. We will make every effort to be sure we can have the show prior to closing. 100% of Entry Fees will be refunded.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 4) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entries received prior to the published opening date and time of entries or received prior to the publishing of this premium list will be returned without processing.

A service/processing fee of \$7.00 will be charged to each duplicate entry.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Show Secretary is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.50 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

FAX/EMAIL ENTRIES AND PAPER ENTRIES WITH CREDIT CARD ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE METHODS FOR ENTRIES AND WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. Online Entries and Checks by Mail are not affected by this change. If mailing be sure to have the entry with check enclosed arrive prior to the closing date of the show. Please note all entries received via fax or email and/or paper entries with credit card information will be shredded/deleted immediately upon delivery without processing. AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition!

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four- to - Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, September 2, 2020 at Superintendent's office.

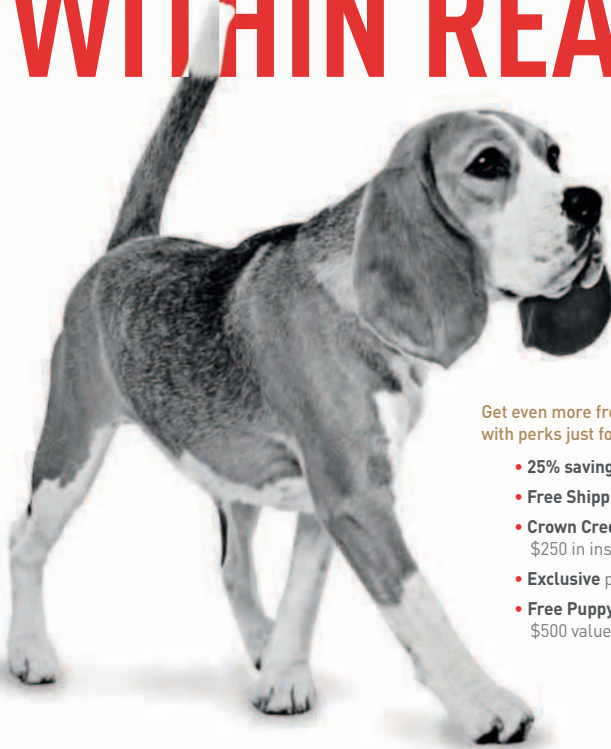

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
