Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

NR1.08100.20800. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years & under 10 years.

NR1.08100.37100. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches 10 years & over.

Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may compete in Veteran Classes at independent specialties.

NR1.08200. Hunting Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches that have earned at least one point towards the AKC Master Hunter title, or who have obtained the Hunting Beagle Novice (HBN) title, or who have placed in the top 10 at the NBC Triple Challenge.

NR1.08500. Field Trial Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches that have placed first, second, third or fourth in an AKC licensed of member field trial.

Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may be entered in these classes.

Winners from the above classes are eligible to compete for Best of Variety if undefeated in any other class.

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the get. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NR2.09300. Brace - Two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry and entered in another class. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

80000. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class. Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club. All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar. A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring. At a Group or Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.

No online entries will be available, mailed or day of show entry only. In addition to an entry, a Pee Wee Release of Liability must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

Entry fee is free as additional entry for an entered dog. If only entering the Pee Wee Class, **entry fee is \$15.00. There is no limit on the number of children allowed to enter the class.**

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.
